Opportunities in Wisconsin

League of Women Voters of Wisconsin: Election Day Observer Help LWV-WI monitor Wisconsin's elections. Train as an Election Observer and work in polling places in specific areas around the state on November 3rd. LWV-WI provides training, assigns volunteers to polling place(s), and supplies volunteers with a form to record their observations. You don't need to be a League member to do this. Four areas of focus:

1. monitor central count locations and observe the absentee ballot counting process
2. ensure there is no disenfranchisement
3. monitor the voter experience
4. track any problems that can be fixed for future elections
